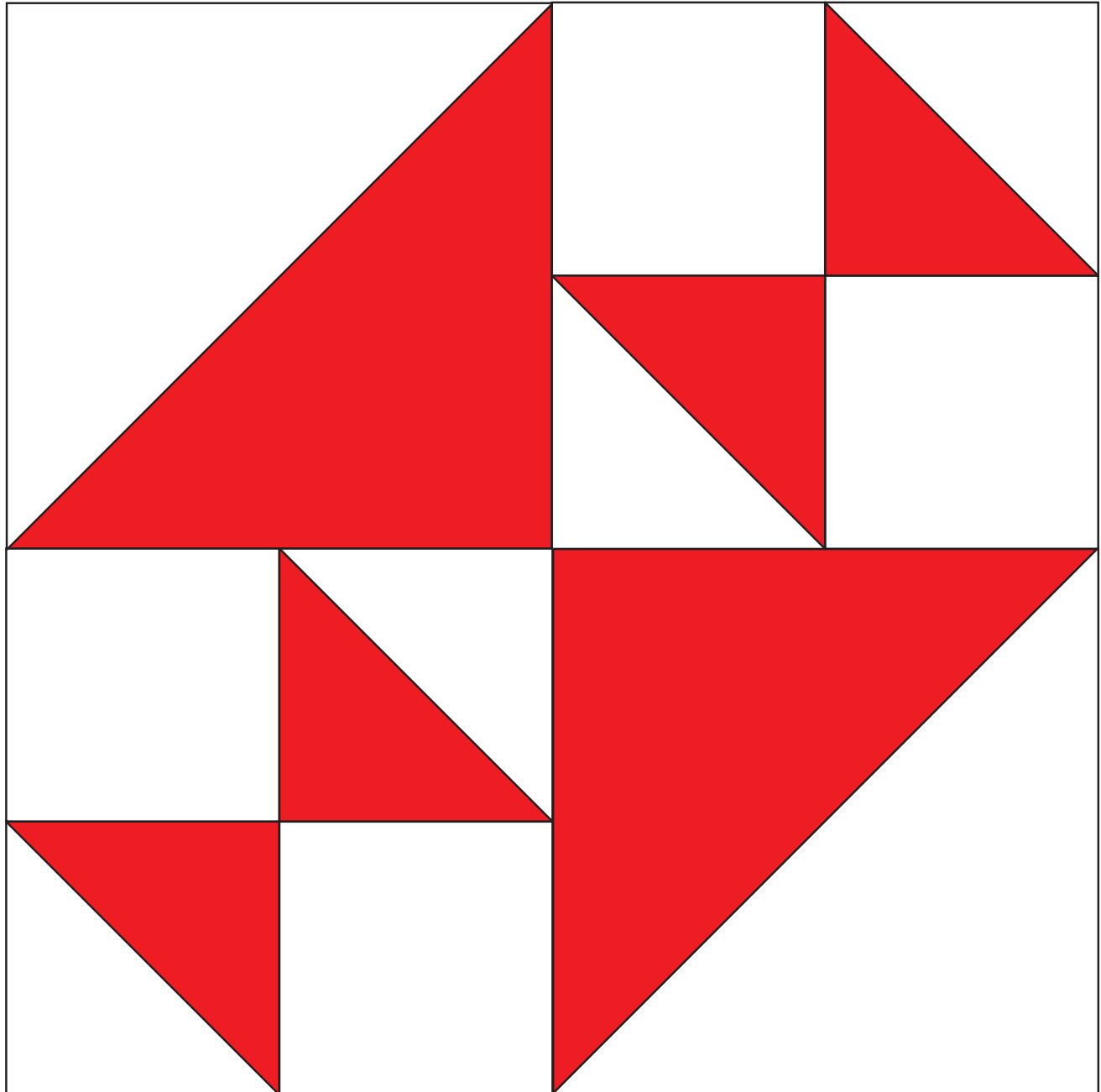




Goose & Goslings

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 12" x 12"



Crosses and Losses is the name of a quilt block that was derived from the Bible. Since this block is made up almost entirely of triangles, we show you how to make half-square triangle units using oversize squares that are sewn together and trimmed to size to ensure piecing accuracy.

Goose & Goslings Block

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Read through entire pattern before beginning project. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances with fabric right sides together. Pressing arrows are included with illustrations. Basic quilting supplies are assumed.

HST= half-square triangle

FABRIC:

- **Fabric A:** 9 1/2" x 22" rectangle light fabric- Provided- Gray Batic
- **Fabric B:** 9" x 17" rectangle medium or dark fabric- From your stash

CUTTING:

- **From Fabric A, cut:**
 - (1) 7" x 7" square
 - (2) 4" x 4" squares
 - (4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares
- **From Fabric B, cut:**
 - (1) 7" x 7" square
 - (2) 4" x 4" squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1 Use a pencil to draw a diagonal line on wrong side of **Fabric A** 7" square. Place marked square over **Fabric B** 7" square. Referring to **Diagram 1**, sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut unit in half on drawn line and press to make (2) **HST Units**. Trim to 6 1/2" square. Make 2.

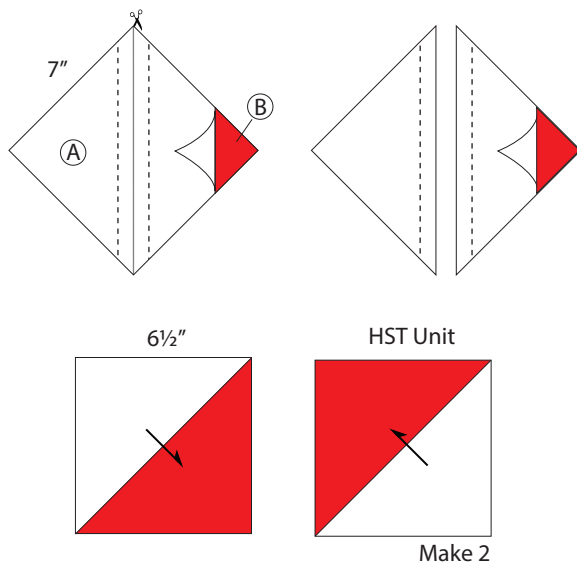


DIAGRAM 1

2 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of (2) **Fabric A** 4" squares. Place (1) **Fabric A** 4" square over **Fabric B** 4" square. Referring to **Diagram 2**, sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut unit in half on drawn line and press to make (2) **HST Units**. Trim to 3 1/2" square. Make 4.

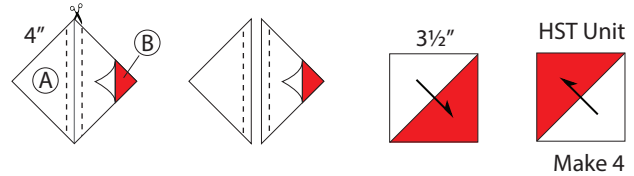


DIAGRAM 2

3 Paying attention to orientation, lay out (2) **Fabric A** 3 1/2" squares and (2) 3 1/2" **HST Units** as shown in **Diagram 3**. Sew together into rows. Stitch rows together to make **Corner Unit**. Make 2.

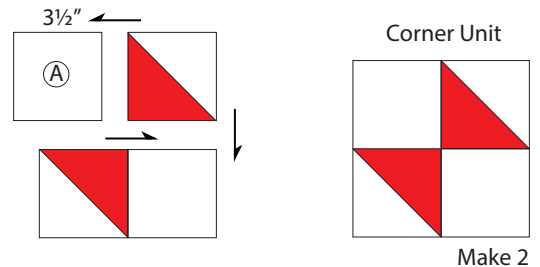


DIAGRAM 3

4 Paying attention to orientation, lay out (2) **Corner Units** and (2) 6 1/2" **HST Units** as shown in **Diagram 4**. Sew units into rows. Sew rows together to make **Goose & Goslings Block**.

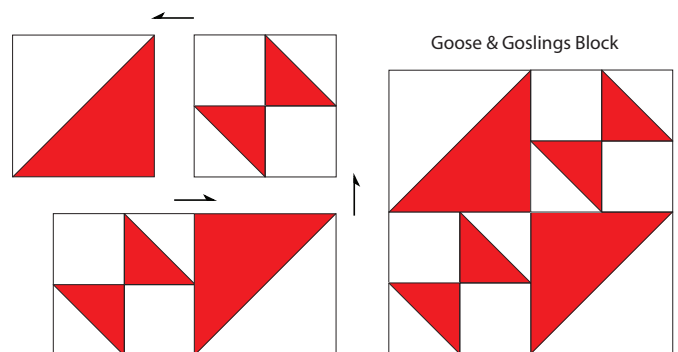
