


Goose & Goslings

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 12" x 12"



Crosses and Losses is the name of a quilt block that was derived from the Bible. Since this block is made up almost entirely of triangles, we show you how to make half-square triangle units using oversize squares that are sewn together and trimmed to size to ensure piecing accuracy.

Goose & Goslings Block

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Read through entire pattern before beginning project. Use ¼" seam allowances with fabric right sides together. Pressing arrows are included with illustrations. Basic quiltmaking supplies are assumed.

HST= half-square triangle

FABRIC:


- Fabric A: 9 1/2 " x 22" rectangle light fabric- Provided- Gray Batic
- Fabric B: 9" x 17" rectangle medium or dark fabric- From your stash

CUTTING:


- From Fabric A, cut:
 - (1) 7" x 7" square
 - (2) 4" x 4" squares
 - (4) 31/2" x 31/2" squares
- From Fabric B, cut:
 - (1) 7" x 7" square
 - (2) 4" x 4" squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:


Use a pencil to draw a diagonal line on wrong side of Fabric A 7" square. Place marked square over Fabric B 7" square. Referring to Diagram 1, sew a ¼" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut unit in half on drawn line and press to make (2) HST Units. Trim to 6½" square. Make 2.



2 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of (2) Fabric A 4" squares. Place (1) Fabric A 4" square over Fabric B 4" square. Referring to Diagram 2, sew a ¼" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut unit in half on drawn line and press to make (2) HST Units. Trim to 3½" square. Make 4.



Paying attention to orientation, lay out (2) **Fabric A** 3½" squares and (2) 3½" **HST Units** as shown in **Diagram 3**. Sew together into rows. Stitch rows together to make **Corner Unit**. Make 2.



Paying attention to orientation, lay out (2) Corner Units and (2) 6½" HST Units as shown in Diagram 4. Sew units into rows. Sew rows together to make Goose & Goslings Block.
