Quilt Specifications:

- Size: Minimum perimeter: 96" (e.g., 24" x 24"); Maximum perimeter: 150" (e.g., 30" x 45")
- **Techniques:** Use any quilting methods--hand or machine piecing, applique, embellishing, beading, thread painting, paper piecing, fabric painting, photo printing, or fabric manipulation. Let your creativity shine!
- **Quilt Definition**: Your quilt must have three layers (top, batting, backing), be quilted by hand or machine, and bound.
- **Hanging Sleeve**: Please attach a 4" sleeve at the top for display.
- **Fabric**: No special fabrics are required.
- Category: This is a non-judged category, open to all members—new or experienced.
