

LEARN HOW TO BEAD ON FABRIC

Class Objective: To complete a beaded embroidery sampler using an 8” block to learn all the basic beaded stitches. You will learn about the different beads and sizes, what kind of thread to use, how to encase a found object with beads, and the several types of border patterns and fringes. Prior knowledge of basic embroidery stitches would be helpful.

Beaded Block Kit – Cost \$20.00, includes: Note: **you will be choosing your own fabric and bead colors

- 1 9” fabric block (there will be a delightful selection for you to choose from) **
- 1 – 9” backing fabric **
- 1 – 9” batting (optional)
- 1 – 8” Lacy’s Stiff Stuff (stabilizer)
- 1 – Nymo D Beading Thread – neutral color
- 1 each – Beading needles, sizes 10, 11 and 12
- 1 each – 3 colors of seed beads (size 15) **
- 1 each – 3 colors of seed beads (size 11) **
- 1 each – 2 colors of seed beads (size 8) **
- 1 each – 1 color seed beads (size 6) **
- 1 each – 1 color bugle beads, size 3**
- 1 packet – 6 sequins, four glass beads (leaf, drop, donut & disk), one cabochon, stone, or glass

You need to bring to class:

- Small embroidery scissors
- Needle Threader, if needed or magnifiers or portable light
- Your lunch & a beverage

Note: If you wish to purchase beads for future projects, payment will be collected at the end of class.
