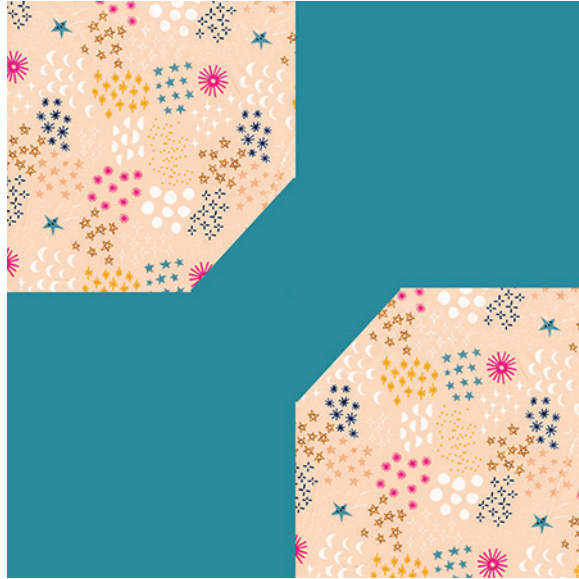
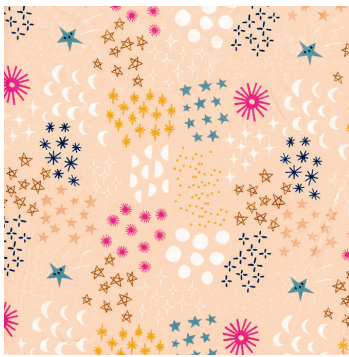


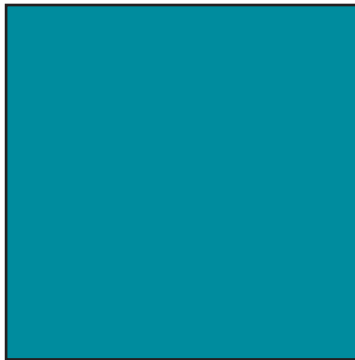
Bow Tie Block



12-inch Finished Blocks



Background: cut two 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



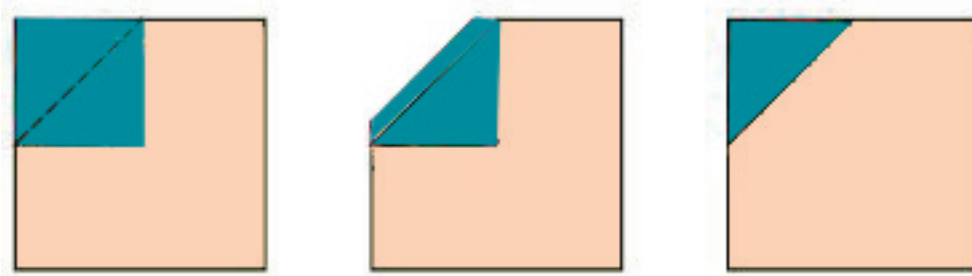
Bow Tie Fabric:
cut two 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
cut two 3" x 3 inch" squares.

Making a Block

Draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner on the reverse side of each 3-inch square.

Align a marked square with one corner of a background square, right sides together.

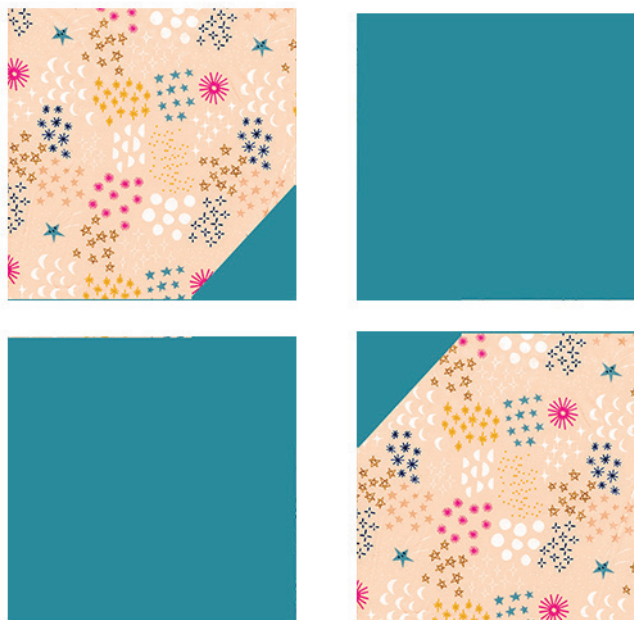
Sew a seam directly on the marked line.



Trim away excess fabric from both layers 1/4" past the seam line.

Press as is to set the seam and then press the seam allowance towards the large square.

Sew the remaining small square to a corner of the remaining background square.



Arrange the pieced units and two bow tie squares into two rows as shown. Sew components of each row together and press seam allowances towards the large bow tie square.

Sew the two rows together. Press.
