SCRAPPY NINE PATCH

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Read through entire pattern before beginning project. Use ¼" seam allowances with fabric right sides together. Pressing arrows are included with illustrations. Basic quiltmaking sup-plies are assumed. Fabric requirements include extra yardage for shrinkage and insurance.

You can use multiple colors or whatever you would like on this- it is a scrap buster so have fun! You are allowed to make as many as you want!

~Make sure you include the slip with your name and add how many blocks you finished.

This will make a 9" block

CUTTING:

From Fabric A, cut:

• (4) 3½" x 3½" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

• (5) 3½" x 3½" squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Paying attention to placement, lay out (4) **Fabric A** 3½" squares and (5) **Fabric B** 3½" squares as shown in **Diagram 1.** Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make **Nine Patch Block.**
