

SCRAPPY NINE PATCH

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Read through entire pattern before beginning project. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances with fabric right sides together. Pressing arrows are included with illustrations. Basic quilting supplies are assumed. Fabric requirements include extra yardage for shrinkage and insurance.

CUTTING:

From Fabric A, cut:

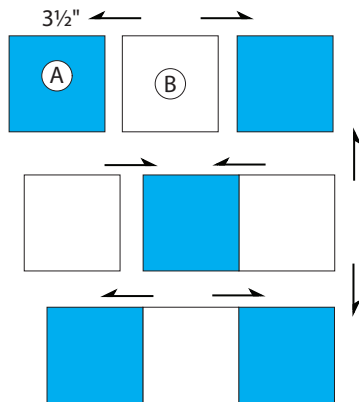
- (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric B, cut:

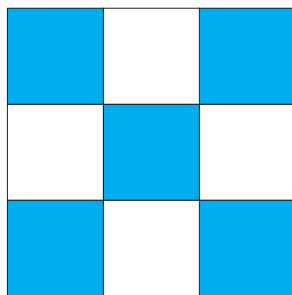
- (5) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1 Paying attention to placement, lay out (4) **Fabric A** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (5) **Fabric B** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares as shown in **Diagram 1**. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make **Nine Patch Block**.

You can use multiple colors or whatever you would like on this- it is a scrap buster so have fun! You are allowed to make as many as you want!

~Make sure you include the slip with your name and add how many blocks you finished.

This will make a 9" block
