Instructions for the August 2022 Block

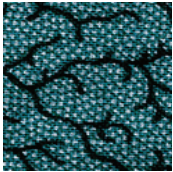
You will need:



Fabric 1, plain white muslin:
Two squares, 5" x 5"
One strip 2 1/2" x 10"



Fabric 2, red print or solid:
two squares 5" x 5"

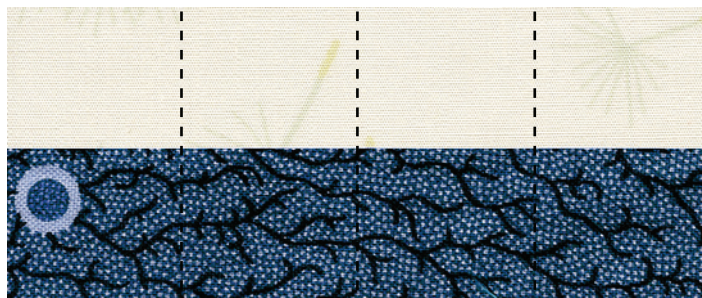


Fabric 3, blue print or solid:
One strip, 2 1/2" x 10"
One 2 1/2" square

Stack one square of each color, right sides together. Cut across diagonally, creating 4 half square triangles. Sew together along the diagonal. Press toward the darker fabric, then trim to 4 1/2". Repeat with the second set of squares.

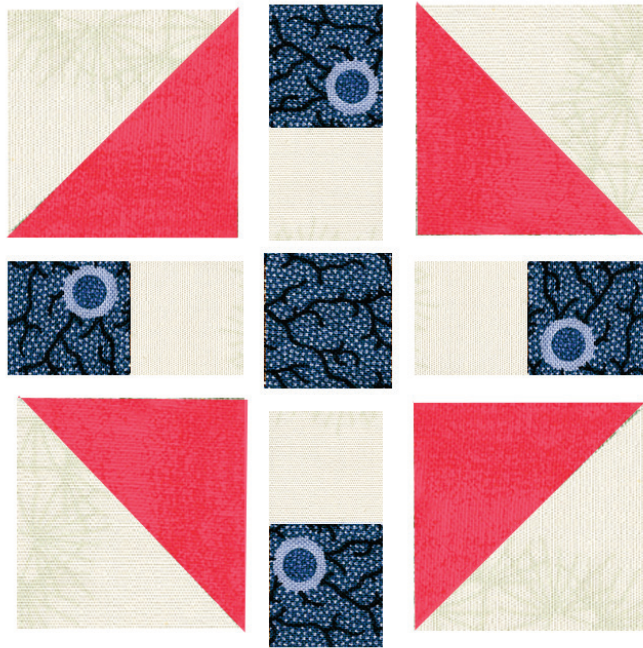


Sew the strips of Fabric one and fabric 3 together along the long edge. Press the seam to the dark side, then cut into 2 1/2" segments.

Arrange the block this way:



Create horizontal rows, as shown. Then join the rows to complete the block. The final block will be 10 1/2" inches square (10" finished).
